Our Mission

Arlington Neighborhood Village helps Arlington's older residents continue living in their own homes as they age by providing access to support services and social activities.



If you are 55 or older and live in Arlington County, you are eligible to join Arlington Neighborhood Village. There are two **membership categories**:

Full Membership* entitles you to take part in all programs and social activities and to receive volunteer services. The annual fee for one person is \$500. The fee for each additional member in a household is \$250.

Associate Membership entitles you to take part in all programs and social activities but not volunteer-provided services. The annual fee for one person or a household is \$500, some of which may be deductible.

Services for Full Members

- * **Transportation** to your doctor, the grocery store, and on errands up to 3 times per week
- * **Household tasks** like changing light bulbs, decluttering, and moving boxes or simple repairs
- * **Errands** such as picking up prescriptions or groceries
- * **Technology assistance** with computers, phones and TVs
- * **Occasional yard care**
- * **Social visits** to play cards, chat or go for walks in your neighborhood

All services are provided by volunteers who have been screened and trained.
